## About Our TNR Efforts in the Community

[e-rescue-houston.org](http://e-rescue-houston.org) has been helping the community and feral cats for over 5 years by helping to Trap/Neuter/Return (TNR) Cats who are not adoptable. One area we concentrate on is Willowbrook Mall. Since 2017, we have been making sure the Cats living there have daily food/water and are fixed. If we happen upon a litter of Kittens, they are trapped and taken to a Foster Home to be socialized for adoption. This Fall as with all other Falls we have been preparing so we have enough food for them and thanks to your generous donations, the Cats will be set through the Winter.

We also paid to have over 40 Cats TNR'd throughout North West Houston in order to keep the feral population under control. The cost to fix and vaccinate one feral cat is 60.00. ## Quarterly Status

We currently have kittens available for adoption at [e-rescue-houston.org](http://e-rescue-houston.org). These kittens are “posted for adoption” or “preparing for vetting to post”. Of the 115 cats & kittens this year we have adopted 87 so far. Ninety seven (97) were fully vetted before they were adopted, while the remainder were pre-adopted before vetting them and then adopting them. Currently we have twenty eight (28) that are available for adoption, but these numbers change daily so please visit our website.

The website now has our featured daily kitten, a listing of all available kittens and many resources for new and existing visitors. The website is responsive in that it works well on mobile phones, tablets and desktops. The website provides the following:

- A menu on every page: button menu on desktop, bar menu (☰) on mobile devices. The menus contain: links to our adoption application, a foster application, a “Help” page, a “Support Us” page an “About” page and a link to Donate.
- The main page contains our daily featured cats/kittens and all available kittens and also a short list of resources and sponsor/partner links.
- The “Help” page contains helpful resources for the new adopter and helpful resources for those wanting to save and trap neuter and return (TNR) cats from the streets.
- The “Support Us” page contains a “Why Donate?” section, a “Happy Tails” section and helpful resources on how to donate and help regularly at little-to-no additional cost via our sponsor & partners.
- The “About” page contains information on us and what we are all about.

## Adoptable Rescues & Our Process:

All our rescues are posted on our website at [e-rescue-houston.org](http://e-rescue-houston.org), on [PetFinder](#) & [Adopt-a-Pet](#), [Facebook](#) and other sites to increase their chances of getting a forever home.

All our rescues are in foster homes mostly in the Houston area, but some may be in other parts of Texas, so please look closely at the description details where they are posted.

Adoption events are held at [PetSmart Willowbrook](#) (FM 1960/HWY 249 - 17723 Tomball Pkwy Houston, TX 77064) on the 1st and 3rd weekends of the month. Sometimes when intake is high we will hold events on both days: primarily Saturday from 11am to 3pm and Sundays from 12pm to 3pm.

### Our Process:

1. **Submit an application** using the “Adopt” menu link on our website or go to: [Adoption Application](#). Please completely fill out the adoption application so that we can find the best forever home for the kitty. Also ensure that everyone in the household is ready to adopt before applying.
2. **Interview** - coordinate with us by phone (we will call), after a complete adoption application review by us.
3. **Meet your kitten:** coordinate by phone for an appointment with the foster, after adoption application review and approval.

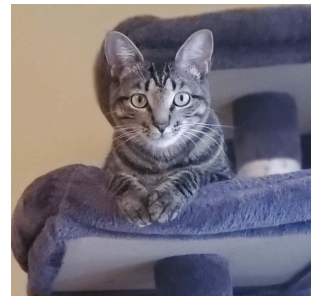

## About Us

e-Rescue Houston is a 501c3 non-profit , no kill rescue group. Most of our rescues come from neighborhoods and shelters in and around the Houston area. We operate only on a small adoption fee and donations from the public.

Our rescue was created over 16 years ago, when we would save a mix of dogs & cats from area shelters. Our roots were in electronic bulletin boards, hence the 'e' in our name. We would pull rescues from kill shelters before they were euthanized, and after getting them spayed/neutered, we adopted them to forever homes.

We currently TNR (Trap / Neuter / Return) feral cats to keep the population down and save many kittens from living the feral life by putting them in foster homes where they are socialized. Then we put them up for adoption once they have been fully vetted.
